**Michael Noll** is a graduate-level instructor in the School of Public Affairs at the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs, teaching courses in intelligence. He retired in 2010 as Director of Intelligence (J2) for North American Aerospace Defense Command, US Northern Command and Director of Joint Intelligence Operations Center North, where he was responsible for a team charged with warning, threat characterization and knowledge of the human and physical environment of North America. The intelligence missions conducted by JIOC North included counter-terrorism, countering transnational crime, missile defense, air and maritime threat warning and Arctic security issues. Mr. Noll was also commander of US European Command's Joint Analysis Center and holds an M.A. in National Security Studies from Georgetown University.

**Denise Maes** is ACLU of Colorado's Public Policy Director. Previously she was partner in the law firm of Berenbaum, Weinshienk & Easton, and was recognized as one of the Top Seven Women Lawyers by *Law Week Colorado* in 2009. She has served as General Counsel for the White House Office of Administration for President Barack Obama, and directed Budget and Finance operations for Vice President Joe Biden. She is co-founder and former Director of the Colorado Latina Initiative, was Director of the Colorado Women's Bar and Hispanic Bar associations. Ms. Maes was cited as "Barrister of the Year" in 2010 by the Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual and Transgender Community Center of Colorado.
