SUBJECT: Terrorist Contact

On 08-24-02, I was dispatched to a three car accident in the 1300 block of N. Sheridan Blvd. Upon my arrival, another officer was already on scene gathering all of the necessary information from the drivers. The driver at fault, slammed into the vehicle in front of him and that vehicle hit the vehicle in front of it. The at fault driver is identified as [REDACTED]. Upon clearing him, he came back with two different PIN's, one stating he had a valid license and the other one showing it to be suspended, due to nonpayment of child support. The valid license PIN is [REDACTED] and the suspended PIN is [REDACTED]. Upon clearing his vehicle, LIC#[REDACTED], a caution warning came up, stating he was a member of a terrorist organization. It stated he was with the militia. He is a white male, 6-0, 160, long blond hair, and blue eyes. A consensual search of his truck revealed a loaded handgun in the glove compartment. It is a 45 caliber black and silver semiautomatic, AMT, serial#[REDACTED]. A clearance of the gun was done, but no record was found. The [REDACTED] and the [REDACTED]. The warning was placed on 01-31-02. His social security number is [REDACTED] and he currently resides at [REDACTED], Lakewood, CO 80226. I notified the FBI about the contact as well.
